



Driving from Bukoba towards Kamachumu, The historic church of Kagondo Parish becoms you with a command to pay a visit. This is a 100 year old marvel of mudbrick architecture. Proceeding from Kagondo there are two options

TOUR 3: UNCOVER THE SECRETS OF BU KOKA

Experience the border with Uganda. Uganda is where the rest of the Martyrs of Uganda besides Martyr Jean Marie Muzeezi came from and is where all Martyrs were burnt to death at a place called Namugongo.

Witness first hand ancient fabric technology from tree bark, capture the essence of the peoples age long skills as you observe the making of bar cloth from the bark of fig trees found in Minziro Forest.

On the route from Bukoba to Kishomberwa you are passing through the historic battle fields of the battle between Tanzania and Idd Amin of Uganda. Time and time again listen to stories from your guide and see the historic remains and sites of the war.

Immerse again in Spiritual worship at Nyakijooga the Lourdes of Bukoba and finish off the tour with the visit to the rare ancient Rock Art of Bwanjai.

End of the tour return to Bukoba.

Option 1 Adventure scenic hiking in the pillars of the Kamachumu Escarpment. Hiking for two to three hours through the pillars holding the Kamachumu escarpment is unanimously considered to be the most exiting adventure tour experience among all we offer. Marvel at the tranquility of long Bugonzi water fall and see the breathtaking valley below. Then proceed to Rutabo Parish.

Option 2 Drive up the Escarpment. If not keen on adventure hiking, proceed from Kagondo by bus passing through sweeping views of banana and tea plantations all the way to Bugonzi Water falls for unsurpassed scenery of the land and rivers that lie below the escarpment.

The infectious spirit of worship at Rutabo Parish invites you to see the historic Bishop house of Cardinal Rugambwa. From here you visit his home where he was born in the village of Bukongo.

Finish Kamachumu tour with a visit to the Mushonge Museum a 100 years old delicate monument of intricate traditional architecture before returning to Bukoba.

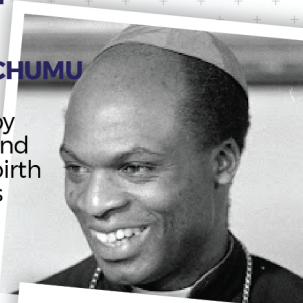
BOAT TOUR TO MUSILA ISLAND
